General Practitioners offer daily clinics from Monday to Fridays at Cape Cornwall Surgery. Patients can either phone and book on the day to see a Doctor or book into a pre-bookable clinic slot, subject to availability of slots, which are provided by all

doctors. Doctors from Cape Cornwall Surgery hold weekly branch surgeries at Sennen, St Buryan and Poljigga

An out of hour's service is provided by SERCO.

Cape Cornwall Surgery currently provides a comprehensive range of primary care services to its patient population as follows:

## **Management of chronic disease**

This encompasses a wide range of conditions which require long term treatment and care. Our priority is to ensure this care is on-going and appropriate; to this end we shall endeavour to review patients' medication on an annual basis. Diabetic, Stroke, CHD, Respiratory clinics are regularly held throughout the year.

## **General nursing care**

Our nurses provide wound care, contraceptive services, minor illness, smoking cessation advice, well person checks, new patient checks, blood pressure monitoring and travel advice; they also perform vaccinations, ear syringing and smear tests.

## **Maternity services**

Midwife clinics are held regularly at the surgery. The doctors also provide ante-natal and postnatal care.

## **Cervical screening**

This service is provided by registered Practice Nurses.

## **Family Planning and Contraceptive services**

This is provided by doctors and nurses. Nurses are able to provide follow up contraception monitoring for all methods initiated by the doctor.

## **Child health surveillance**

Baby clinics are held weekly at the surgery by our nurse team with support from a doctor.

## **Vaccinations and immunisations**

Cape Cornwall Surgery strongly supports childhood immunisation programme. All routine childhood immunisations are performed at the surgery by a nurse following an automatic invitation from the Local Health Authority. Cape Cornwall Surgery offers all 'at risk' patients the seasonal influenza vaccine from September to January every year.

## **Foreign Travel Health Advice**

Our nurses have been trained to provide an up to date service that includes vaccinations if necessary (please note that there is a charge for some vaccinations).

## **Counselling**

Cape Cornwall Surgery provides access to a NHS commissioned counselling services with appointments available at the surgery on a weekly basis.

## **Smoking Cessation**

Practice Nurses offer appointments to patients who wish to attend a smoking cessation clinic.

## **Weight Loss clinic**

Appointments are provided by our nurse team to offer help, support and advice to patients who want to lose weight and maintain a healthier lifestyle.

## **Phlebotomy**

Cape Cornwall Surgery employs a fully qualified Health Care Assistant who runs a daily Phlebotomy Clinic.

## **Substance Misuse**

Cape Cornwall Surgery has a Substance Misuse GP specialist (GPWsi) Dr Ellery. A fortnightly substance misuse clinic is held at the surgery.

## **Minor Surgery**

Weekly minor surgery clinics are held at Cape Cornwall by either Dr Ellery or Dr Mackenzie.

## **Minor Injuries Service**

The NHS has commissioned Cape Cornwall Surgery to provide a minor injuries service to registered patients and temporary residents.

## **NHS Health Checks**

Cape Cornwall Surgery offers appointments for NHS health checks both during the working week and once a month at a Saturday clinic.

## **Dispensary Service**

Cape Cornwall Surgery provides patients with a Dispensary Service; we aim to dispense authorised prescription requests within **two** working days. Patients can

submit repeat prescription requests by post, by placing it in the repeat prescription box or order through the practice website.

## **Non – NHS Services Offered at the Practice include the following:**

- Private medical insurance reports and medicals
- Sports, pre-employment and HGV medicals.
- Non NHS vaccinations.

## **GP Training Practice**

Cape Cornwall Surgery was authorised by the NHS in 2011/12 to be a GP Training Practice; Dr Ellery (Training Partner) is allocated GP Registrars on an on-going basis to be trained at Cape Cornwall Surgery.

## **Clinical Research**

Cape Cornwall Surgery has for a number of year's undertaken clinical research and has a well-established clinical research unit which has a reputation for high standards within the clinical research arena.

## **Governance**

Cape Cornwall Surgery ensures that its governance arrangements are robust and regular governance meetings are held as follows:

- Weekly clinical governance meetings that are attended by all GP's, GP Registrar, Community Matron and practice management.
- Monthly Multi- disciplinary Team Meetings that are attended by both clinicians from Cape Cornwall Surgery and clinicians from community teams.
- Quarterly governance meetings to review governance issues from across the governance agenda; these are attended by all GP's and practice management.

The registered location is the main surgery site and it situated close to a local bus stop and directly adjacent to the main Town Car Park. Significant recent investment in to the refurbishment of the premises has provided both patients and staff at the Practice with a modern health care facility. There are two waiting areas available for patients, each providing a comfortable waiting space; the main waiting room provides toilet facilities for patients which includes a separate disabled toilet. Located within the disabled toilet are baby nappy changing facilities. There are six clinical consultation rooms downstairs to provide easy access for patients in wheelchairs or with pushchairs or prams. There is also a fully fitted out Emergency Room should anyone require immediate emergency care. The practice building is also served by a lift which provides access to the first floor clinical room and office space. Cape Cornwall Surgery operates a smoke-free policy.
